# From the Principal:

Over the last couple of weeks there has been considerable professional learning taking place throughout the staff. As part of the work with our Teaching Partners, our leadership team attended a two day conference to work on the VRPS approach to teaching literacy and looking at our structures within the school that support this work. This has helped to solidify our plan for literacy improvement over 2019 and beyond.

We were also in attendance at the Agile Schools Learning Sprints conference. This conference was attended by schools from all over the country as well as some from Canada. Last year we embarked on our journey as an Agile School with Dr Ryan Dunn who worked with our whole staff helping us to understand the structure of learning sprints. These are 4 week cycles that focus on improving teachers' ability to teach a particular skill or understanding. We are looking forward to continuing our work with Dr Dunn in developing our use of this improvement model and ultimately improving learning outcomes for our students.

Later in our newsletter and on Sentral, you will have seen that Anita Elliott has secured a promotion as Principal of Heathmont East Primary School. This is very exciting for Anita and the culmination of years of experience as an Assistant Principal here with us at Victoria Road Primary School.
