




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### School Annual Report


Each year the Department of Education (DET) provides schools with a summary of results compared to similar schools and schools in the state of Victoria. Our results are in red. 'Strong and Exceeding' refers to children who have achieved results above expected levels for their age.





Student opinion data is collected across the state in the Attitudes to School Survey every year. Our student results are in red. They have demonstrated outstanding responses to questions about a wide range of questions about their educational experience in our school. They feel cared for in their school and know they have trustworthy adults at school they can ask for help. They see Victoria Road as a stimulating place to learn and are fully aware of the dispositions of a great learner.

When asked about how effective our teaching was the response from our students was overwhelmingly positive. Our co-teaching model assists us in delivering engaging learning experiences in a calm environment where learning behaviours are exemplary.
