Student opinion data is collected across the state in the Attitudes to School Survey every year. Our students have demonstrated outstanding responses to questions about a wide range of topics. They feel cared for by staff and know they have trustworthy adults at school they can ask for help. They see Victoria Road as a stimulating place to learn and are fully aware of the dispositions of a great learner. When asked about how effective our teaching was the response from our students was overwhelmingly positive. Our co-teaching model assists us in delivering engaging learning experiences in a calm environment where learning behaviours are exemplary.
